I confirm that we hold the information as below.

- 1) Please can you provide me with a list of the number of children who have been treated for eating disorders within the following years 2010 and 2019 and 2020 (so far). To clarify my request, I require the following:
  - By children, I mean those under the age of 18. Please can you break down my request into the following age categories:
  - 0-2; 3-5 6-7; 8-9; 10; 11; 12; 13; 14; 15; 16; 17-18



For b, if possible, can you outline the reasons and the year please. 2A) Can you tell me how many patients waited more than 6 months and a year for their treatment during the years 2010 and 2019 and 2020 (so far).
  - a) 2019 average 2.6 Weeks 2020 average 3.8 Weeks
  - b) 2019 longest wait falls within 4-12 weeks 2020 longest wait falls within 4-12 weeks



3) What was the average number of sessions received by patients in 2010 and 2019 and 2020 (so far). broken down by the following diagnoses: anorexia nervosa, bulimia nervosa, BED and OSFED?
